Hamilton Update

- Business in FI Market from Channel Partners was strong in 2021 Thank you.
- Market continues to appear strong positive feedback from partners, national accounts, other providers
- Hamilton United move complete, but will never end
- Innovation launched several new/upgraded products more to come
- Sale of Gunnebo Cash Management business
 - All Hamilton channel partners have access to Gunnebo Cash Management/Sesami products
- Still challenges in our supply chain
 - Extended lead times in some areas electronics, small run components, machining. We have extended POs with key suppliers
 - We continue to insource we purchased a machine shop and will move it into the new facility by the end of Q1.
 - Found second sources for all overseas sourced parts



Hamilton Update

- Pricing
 - In 2021, price increase in April (0 8%), 5% surcharge in July and 5% in October
 - Significant cost increases not offset by surcharges in 2021
 - We continue to see significant cost increases in some key areas mainly steel, plastics & electronics.
 - Steel example
 - Plate
 - Hot rolled
 - Cold rolled
 - Rebar
 - Specialty stainless, aluminum, galvanized




Hamilton Update - Steel Costs






Hamilton Update - Steel Costs SteelBenchmarkerTM HRB Price




- January and February difficult months for production we are catching up.





Volume of currency in circulation, in billions of notes as of December 31 of each year



Average Daily Holdings by Age



Cash Use Share by Age Group and Year



Market – Share of In-Person Payment Use


Share of Participants Reporting In-Person Payments During Diary






